### **CHAMPION FOR WOMEN'S WELLBEING**

Mrs. Chandrika Sikotariya is from Veraval City and currently lives in a joint family of fourteen people. She has been the Chairman of the Nagar Palika Standing Committee in Veraval for the past nine months. Additionally, she is a ward councilor, whereby she not only assists her ward people but has also built a robust network of female workers. Passionate about women empowerment, has been organizing seminars and awareness programs on self-defense, menstrual hygiene, food and nutrition, cybercrime, and karate for girls and women. She has facilitated over 2200 free blood group tests for children with the support of Aditya Birla Hospital. Currently, she is helping fifty girls aged ten to sixteen receive special physical training for self-defense and ensures the food and health needs of children at various Anganwadi centers are met. Mrs. Sikotariya is also helping older, uneducated women learn to sign their names, moving away from using thumb impressions. As the current ward councilor, she oversees and supports the Anganwadi centers in her area.

The program is designed to create a level-playing field for individuals from various backgrounds, including students, professionals and those seeking personal development.







### **RUTUJA CHARITABLE TRUST**

RUTUJA, founded by Dr. Nehal Shah, is a non-profit organization dedicated to enhancing women's health and education. Initially an awareness website on her research on Premenstrual Syndrome in 2010, it evolved into the RUTUJA Charitable Trust, offering free programs in health, education, vocational training, skill development and mental well-being. RUTUJA conducts workshops, seminars, and campaigns like the Red Dot Challenge for menstrual hygiene and the Orange Campaign against violence. The organization also provides regular sessions through their 4 online clubs like menopause club, period club, book lovers club & mental health club. During COVID-19, RUTUJA held 65 mental health and meditation sessions. 

There's a dustbin, a library filled with magazines and books and an MP3 speaker playing songs. Additionally, two boxes offer water bottles and homemade Gujarati snacks from his wife. He gifts badges & smileys to all passengers and gives toys, comic books and chocolates to children. Upon reaching the destination, he hands you an envelope and looks away, not asking for anything. You can pay whatever you want, with the meter reading zero. The principle of the Gift Economy entails paying forward for someone in need, where the rider before you covers your travel costs, and you pay it forward for the next. During COVID-19, he prioritized safety with sanitizer, masks, and aid distribution, strictly following government guidelines. His passion enriches every journey, inspiring deeper thoughts, broader smiles, and stronger connections.



Initially focusing on severe malnutrition, the foundation has successfully lifted 87% of 117 children out of malnourishment across 19 villages. They continue to distribute nutritious meals and promote menstrual hygiene with reusable sanitary pads. ### **K.J. INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY (KJIT)**

Jayka Jan Sahayak Trust operates the KJIT Campus in Savli, Vadodara, Gujarat. This educational institute offers programs such as B.E., Diploma, BCA, B.A.M.S. (Ayurveda), and vocational skill development courses. The campus includes hostels and a sixty-bed Ayurveda hospital providing free patient care. Additionally, they run the Gyan Shakti Residential School of Excellence in partnership with the Government of Gujarat. With over 2,100 students and more than 275 employees, KJIT focuses on making jobless youth employable through free skill development courses. Their NGO conducts need assessments, creates academic modules, and provides practical training. Youth are then certified through NSDC exams. Popular courses include CNC and VMC operator training. KJIT addresses youth unemployment and moral values, offering free transport, food and study materials. They actively engage with villages to promote education and employment, bridging the industry-academia gap and fostering a skilled workforce.

### **SVADES**

The Society for Village Development in Petrochemicals Area (SVADES), established in 1995, is a unique collective effort uniting industry and rural communities for socio-economic development in Vadodara Taluka, Gujarat. Registered under the Societies Act, 1860, SVADES initially focused on 16 Panchayats, comprising 40 villages and a population of around 200,000. Funded by member industries, community contributions, and governmental grants, SVADES expanded in 2015 to assist other industries in fulfilling their CSR across Vadodara District. SVADES is backed by prominent industries such as Indian Petrochemicals Co. Ltd., Gujarat State Fertilizers Co. Ltd. and Deepak Nitrite Ltd. CSR and other partners include Aditya Medisales Limited, ArcelorMittal Nippon Steel India Limited and Sun Pharmaceutical Limited, among others. The initiatives of SVADES are designed to improve the quality of life in villages through community and industry participation. These initiatives include eco-restoration, sanitation, village infrastructure development, school support, women empowerment and youth capacity building. By reducing women's drudgery, enhancing environmental conditions and providing vocational training, SVADES exemplifies the impact of collective action in the corporate sector for rural development.

### **SECURE NATURE SOCIETY**



Tamil Nadu, with a donation rate of 1.8 per million, serves as a model for the country, where the national rate stands at 0.80 per million.

MOHAN Foundation employs a unique 360-degree approach that includes public education programs to promote awareness, training transplant coordinators to counsel bereaved families, networking with hospitals, and liaising with government bodies to pass favorable legislations. Significant achievements include creating a scalable Indian model for organ donation, launching a diploma course in grief counseling and transplant coordination, and introducing mobile apps for donor optimization and organ donation counseling. The Foundation staff, along with Dr. Shroff, has authored books on 'Legal Aspects of Organ Donation,' 'Religion and Organ Donation,' "You are the Clay, You are the Potter," and "Funding for Dialysis and Transplants: A Comprehensive Compendium." Awarded the 'Best NGO' by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, MOHAN Foundation has sensitized over 250 million people and facilitated more than 70% of India's deceased donations, saving and enhancing 14,600 lives. 

Mr. Balkrishna's unwavering support significantly contributed to countless rescues until his untimely death in 2005. Despite this tragic loss, Ms. Triveni displayed remarkable resilience in continuing their mission. The Rescue Foundation has since saved over 7,000 girls and cared for 11,157 lives. They have reunited 10,778 families, providing comprehensive care plans tailored to each individual in their protective homes. These homes offer medical assistance, educational opportunities and skill development classes. Under Ms. Triveni's leadership, the Foundation expanded its rehabilitation operations, inaugurating homes in Boisar, Pune and Delhi, each supporting 100 survivors. They implemented rehabilitation programs to enable socio-economic empowerment, offering education, healthcare, psychosocial counseling, and various vocational training. The Foundation also established working relationships with government and police officials to facilitate rescue operations and employed legal teams to ensure justice for survivors. Collaborations with organizations like the Ministry of Women & Child Development, International Justice Mission, and Maiti Nepal further enhance their impact. Balkrishna's legacy continues to drive their commitment toward a future free from trafficking, ensuring his spirit lives on in their ongoing efforts.


