# Shri Prabodh Munvar MAAVJYOT SANSTHAN

The sansthan carries out 40 such activities that include carrying out the final funeral rites of people who don't have children, finding the mentally unstable people, old aged people who have got who have got lost and reuniting them with their families, saving girls and women and making sure that they reach their home safely, providing the elderly with food three times a day, etc. Till now the sansthan has carried out final rites of 485 people, reunited 835 mentally unstable people with families, they have saved 185 girls and women.

# Shri Dev Das Goswami DAVO NGO



Dev Das Goswami, a truck driver from Haryana believes, 'When you want to do something good for others, even god will make way for you!' Shri Dev Das Goswami is taking care of the homeless people since last 35 years. Man with a gigantic heart, Goswami takes care of the homeless or abandoned whenever and wherever he sees someone, he brings them to home and takes care of them like family member. The condition of these people drastically change after being bought to Goswamiji's home, thanks to his wife and team who bath them, feed them and take good care until they are sound and healthy once again. Today the count has crossed over 130 but Dev Das Goswami they will always remain "family members".

Dr. Kriti Bharti, hails from Rajasthan. She is determined that she would not let any girl child go through the pains she has suffered at a tender age. Being a victim of child marriage, she very well understands what it feels when childhood is snatched away and alien responsibilities of marriage are burdened on young shoulders. Her fight is against the narrow-minded society who still belive in such traditions and customs. She advocates the educational and social rights of young girls making sure no family falls into trap of child marriage.

Shri Saju Talukdar CLOTH BANK



Mr. Saju Talukdar, our hero from West Bengal believes, to never think twice before doing anything good for others, who knows, they may just be waiting for you!. It all started when he was forced to drop his schooling because he couldn't afford the uniform. As a child Talukdar saw his people working in the tea gardens with bare bodies, he would later work for this when he became a taxi driver. He initiated a process of collecting clothes from villages near his hometown, "Didima" and distributed them among people who were in need of those. People who see him undertaking this job consider him as 'Mad' but he proudly says "If making someone happy is considered to be mad, then I proudly say that YES! I am Mad.' He distributes 4000 clothes a week and continues spreading happiness.

Ms. Mohini Kumar was an acid attack victim in year 2005, today she grooms more than 1500 women per month including rape survivors, domestic violence survivors, acid attack survivors, etc. at Delhi Commission for Women. It was her first day at work, when the guy she rejected earlier threw a jug full of acid on her. She courageously filed a police complaint but that did not stop her from attempting suicide several times. Despite going through depression, she decided not to give up and fight against this injustice. Today she is a happily married woman with naughty five-yearold.

# Shri Vinayak Deokar JEEVAN MITRA PRATISHTHAN CHARITABLE TRUST





B2V works only in organic farming. Very recently it has started its operations in Jharkhand and is going to launch its West Bengal chapter in another 2-3 months.

# Smt. Jabna Chauhan YOUNGEST SARPANCH



Smt. Jabna Chauhan, a hero from Himachal Pradesh, believes in the fact,' Life can be tough, but I am tougher.' Challenges stood against her like a wall, when being a girl she decided to pursue her education in her village. She used to walk 19 Kms. a day to her college, but as it is said hard work always pays, she secured job as a reporter and inspired other girls in her village to pursue education. Looking at her determination and hard work, she was appointed as the sarpanch of her village (Mandi). She became youngest sarpanch of India and has worked for education, alcohol, drug addiction in her village and other such social issues.

### **BALAKNAMA**



Balaknama works on 'Making Voice Heard!'
Balaknama is a group of street kids who have a touching story behind them. The injustice and neglect done to the street kids, was the main reason behind the birth of Balaknama. When the kids did not get an ear to express themselves among the adults, Balaknama came into play, where the kids pen down their thoughts and stories. Team Balaknama includes kids who are rag pickers, working at construction site, fruit and vegetable sellers, etc. They collect stories from streets, tea stalls. They have stood for the empowerment of kids and have covered mesmerizing stories that one would love to read.

### Shri Hirji Bhai Bhingradiya



Shri Hirjibhai works on his belief that, 'Mother earth gives us so much, so it becomes our responsibility to not harm it.' He is working on the concept of organic farming. When he started working in the agricultural sector, the usage of fertilizers in the fields was very common to increase production. Gradually, he realized that such chemical fertilizers are harmful to the land and thus started incorporating organic farming techniques. Now they use organic fertilizers such as cow dung, Agri waste, Vermicompost and use it extensively for farming. They have incorporated mix crop technique of farming so that the efficiency of land doesn't decrease, started crop rotation, made castor oil cakes, incorporated rain water harvesting technique, etc. In addition to this they have also made provision for attracting birds and insects by making a separate area near their farm, as they believe,' They are also a part of our family, so they should stay with us!' There are many species of birds and insects that one can find at his farm.

# Shri Dharmik Bhatt and Shri Yashesh Shah SECURE NATURE SOCIETY



Secure Nature Society, a hero from Mandvi, Kutch believes, 'If you secure the Nature, Nature will secure you.' In everyday life, we come across many instances wherein we feel that change is required, but only a few of us can take the initiative of doing so. Like Secure Nature Society, which is a group of teachers who came forward to take steps towards saving Mother Earth. 'Noori Amma' as she likes herself to be called, continues to nurture her children and live life to her fullest as a dignified respectful woman.

The kids are paid money for their skills and knowledge and are fined for bad behaviour. The kids remain employed at the school till they don't get a suitable profession to work in.

Smt. Pooja Doshi MIMAANSA





Dr. Shashi Rao ANANYA TRUST





# Shri Kotresh Bavihalli PENCIL



Kotresh Bavihalli, a hero from Raichur, believes, 'Give Kids what they like and they will give you what you like.' Mr. Kotresh has worked on the school dropout ratio of the students. He realized that the main reason behind school dropouts is not the infrastructure, but the mundane routine that the students have to go through every single day. So, he started the initiative, 'Pencil' to indulge the students into activities of their interest. Students are more prone to creative activities such as art and craft and so he started indulging them in such activities through 'Pencil.' The students here cover various topics such as stories of their school, village, culture and tradition, etc. The school drop out ratio has gone down drastically and now each month they publish a minimum of 500 copies.

# Shri Shafiqur Rahman Khan EMPOWER PEOPLE



Empower people, works to 'Empower Trafficking Survivors.' The organization works on locating trafficked girls and conducts rescue operations. Dealing with some of the most critical cases, Empower People till now has enabled more than 12k vulnerable children attend school, has intervened in more than 80 honour killing cases, has rescued and relocated more than 4200 girls/women, taken up more than 2700 Domestic violence cases. They work on building Communes that are led by the trafficked victims and has made women leaders in various fields. One of their major activities include, 'March Against Bride Trafficking, 'organized in 2006, 2012 and 2018. The organization supports, protects and organizes Bride Traffickers. They also work for Domestic violence, establishing solidary between trafficked brides so that they can come forward and lead a better life than before.

### Shri Bhupendra Tripathi



Mr. Bhupendra Tripathi believes, 'Never underestimate yourself, because your success is definitely going to prove you wrong one day.' Mr. Tripathi is an epitome of the highest fighting personalities one could have. Having studied Information Technology from NIRMA University and being selected by Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), he has climbed the ladder of success through sheer hard work. Life hit him hard when he was diagnosed with the last stage and paralysis, but when the doctor called him a 'Patient,' he said, 'Who is Patient here? I am a fighter- a survivor, no one is patient here.' Unfortunately, due to cancer he lost his eye sight completely but, he never gave up and cracked multiple exams, including Banking exams. Today, Mr. Tripathi is working as First 100% Blind Manager of RBI-Gujarat & amp; posted in Office of Banking Ombudsman. He is a motivational speaker and an inspiration to many.

# Shri Arkalgud Padmanabha and Shri S Venkata Subba Rao





The 80-year-old duo is working on the fact' Age is just a number!' stench of Government Public toilets in Bangalore.

Shri S Venkata Subba Rao, Founder President of Karnataka Sangha of RBI Bangalore & President of RBI ex Officers Association, apart from the job hs been engaged in several types of social work. He has waged a legal battle for 19 years (1992 and 2011) including a Caveat in the Supreme Court of India and saved the Byrasandra lake, Jayanagar, Bengaluru. The lake has now been revived and rejuvenated. His efforts are continuing to make the lake a beautiful landmark of South Bengaluru.

Shri Arkalgud Padmanabha, has worked with Central Institute of Public Cooperation New Delhi, and later with Harvard University (USA) Centre for Population Studies, India Project, as Behavioral Scientist. He is Founder President of Citizens Forum Yelahanka New Town. Bangalore, & a Trustee of Lake Rejuvenation & Bird Protection Trust. After 15 years of struggle the lake is now declared & recognized as the only Bird Sanctuary in Bangalore. The international migratory birds which had disappeared have begun to come back. Through community organization provided drinking water taps in every street of Sarapaka village Andhra Pradesh, of ten thousand population in 1992, which he considers his best contribution to his mother land till date.
