#### A concise introduction of Dr Jigar Inamdar

During his tenure as Bharatiya Janata Yuva Morcha State Secretary (2006) and General Secretary (2007-2010), he promoted Vistarak Yojna and Abhyas Varg (Training Camps) to the tehsil level. On the occasion of the 150th anniversary of the 1857's first war of independence, a Kranti Gatha Yatra linking the historical sites of Gujarat's freedom movement was organised, and a documentary film was produced (2007). In 2007, at the age of 27, he contested as a BJP candidate for Legislative Assembly Election from the Savli through traditional congress seat and lost by narrow margins.

As Convener (2018) of the Gujarat State Swami Vivekananda Youth Board(SVGRYB), he expanded the network of youth organisations throughout Gujarat and established a structure for the efficient delivery of government programmes in eight zones, 33 districts, and 251 talukas, 161 nagar palikas and 15000 villages. He was instrumental in launch of the Sapta Sankalp Abhiyan (Seven Target Movement) under the leadership of then-Chief Minister Vijay Rupani ji to spread awareness and implement a wide range of social issues, including environmental protection, cleanliness, energy, and health.

From 1996 to 1999, he worked as a student leader at Maharaja Sayajirao University. Since 2007, he has been a member of the Senate-Syndicate and has introduced numerous new initiatives, including the Student Facilitation Center and the Office of Alumni Affairs for linking university alumni.

He is the founding director of the Maharaja Sayajirao University's Institute of Leadership and Governance to foster future leadership (2015), One-year diploma programme in political leadership, as well as the launch of short-term certificate programmes on a variety of disciplines, including the Bhagavad Gita, Kautilya'sArthashastra, Veer Savarkar, and Sardar Patel.

He served as the Indian Council for Cultural Relations' Regional Head for Gujarat (from 2016 to 2022). Under his leadership, he significantly increased the number of foreign students by improving coordination to provide study facilities for foreign students with state educational institutions. He translated Pandit Dindayal Upadhyayji's "Ekatma Manavdarshan" (2015) into Gujarati and Maharaja Sayajirao's administrative training book "Minor Hints" into Hindi (2018). "Veer Savarkar Ekta Aur Akhandata Ke Sadhak," a Hindi book, was edited by him (2019). He has done his Doctorate (2019) on the 'Contemporary Relevance of Sir Sayajirao Gaekwad III's public administration

The globally renowned "ASEAN-India Youth Award 2019" was bestowed upon him in Guwahati for his contributions in the field of youth (2019)

#### AS CONVENER OF SWAMI VIVEKANAND GUJRAT RAJYA YUVA BOARD

- Former Convener of Swami Vivekananda Gujarat State Youth Board (SVGSYB) under Sports, Youth & Cultural Activities Department, Government of Gujarat.
- The initiative was revived by Dr. Jigar Inamdar in November, 2018. Under this initiative, he coordinated around 800 full time youth of Gujarat to create a parallel support structure through more than 15,000 Swami Vivekanand Yuva Kendra at village and nagarpalika level for effective implementation of Government projects and schemes across 8 Zones, 33 Jilla, 251 Taluka, and 161 Nagarpalika. Through "Samvad", workshops, discussion gatherings, and exhibitions will be arranged on a variety of national and international topics. This project entails engaging like-minded people from the country and abroad to exchange ideas, engage in meaningful discourse and synergize energies in the right direction.

#### 2. Srushti (Creation/The World)

(The creation/world is what you see with the eyes and feel with the touch. So, to add colors to the lives of those who know no colors other than the dark, let's decide to donate our eyes after death to add color to their lives. Likewise, let's decide to donate organs after our demise so that our organs can give a new life to someone. Same way, let's decide to ensure that after our demise, our body is donated to solve the shortage of dead bodies to be utilized in further studies and research in Medical Sciences.) Organizing frequent blood donation camps by "Srushti" is a unique intervention to enhance the sense of compassion in the community. This will be a modest attempt to strengthen the sense of altruism in society.

#### 3. Samvedna (Sensation)

With the medium of "Samvedna", appropriate guidance will be offered to patients and their families admitted in the government hospitals. The trial will begin at Sir Sayajirao General Hospital in Vadodara.

#### 4. Sanskruti (Culture)
